



COVID-19 Stakeholder and Influencer Toolkit

Overview

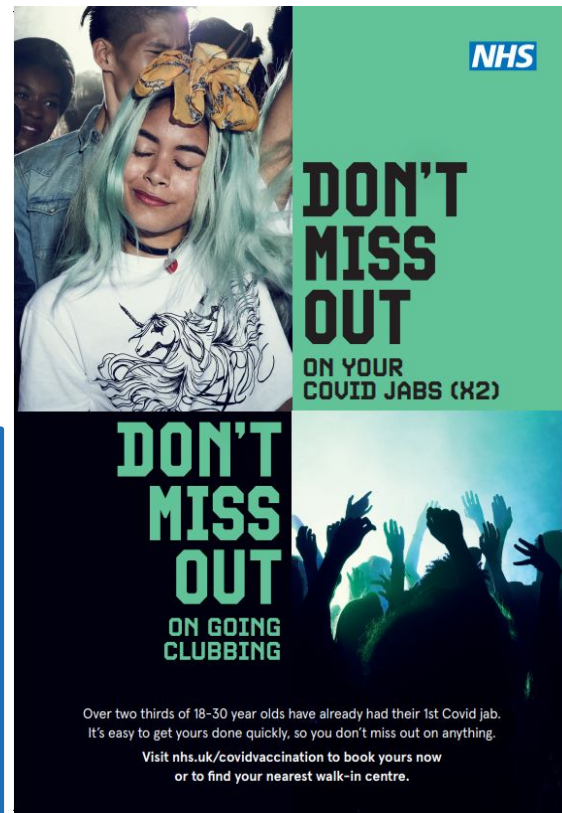
All people aged 16 and 17 in England will be offered [a first dose of a COVID-19 vaccine by Monday 23 August](#) to give them protection before returning to school.

People who are fully vaccinated, or aged under 18, are [no longer legally required to self-isolate](#) if identified as a close contact of a positive COVID-19 case.

Everyone is encouraged to take a [free rapid lateral flow test twice a week](#) to help stop the spread of COVID-19.

Key messages

- Young people [aged 16 and 17 in England will be offered a first dose of a COVID-19 vaccine by Monday 23 August](#).
- More than 70% of young people aged 18 to 29 in England have received a first dose of a COVID-19 vaccine.
- Ventilation stops the spread of COVID-19.





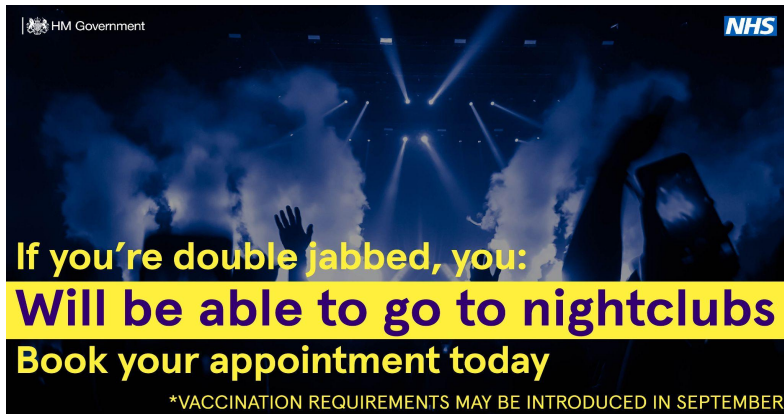
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Young people

More than 70% of young people aged 18 to 29 in England have received a first dose of a COVID-19 vaccine.

How you can help

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Vaccines

More than 47.4 million people have now received their first COVID-19 vaccine dose (89%) and more than 40.9 million have had their second dose (77%).

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Testing

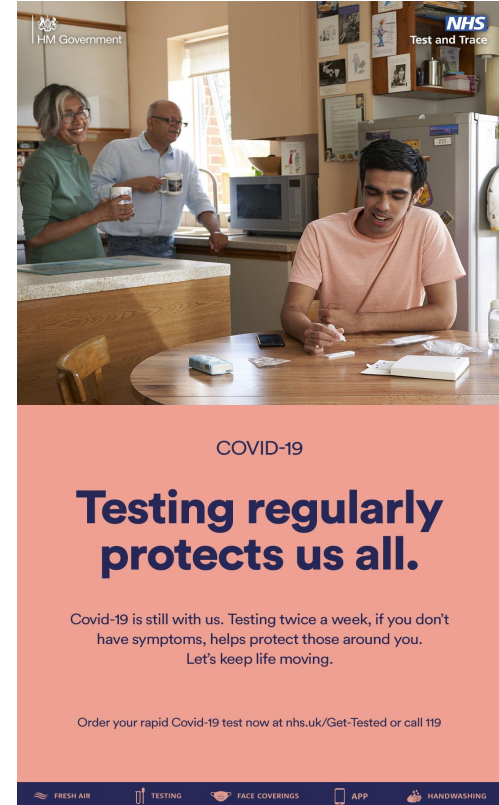
One in three people who catch the COVID-19 virus will not show any symptoms at all. It is important we keep testing to protect ourselves, the people we love, and our communities.

Everyone is encouraged to take a [free rapid lateral flow test twice a week](#) to help stop the spread of COVID-19.

There are [guides in different formats and languages](#) for how to do a rapid lateral flow test for those without symptoms. People with symptoms should [book a laboratory test called a polymerase chain reaction \(PCR\) test](#).
