What are we doing?

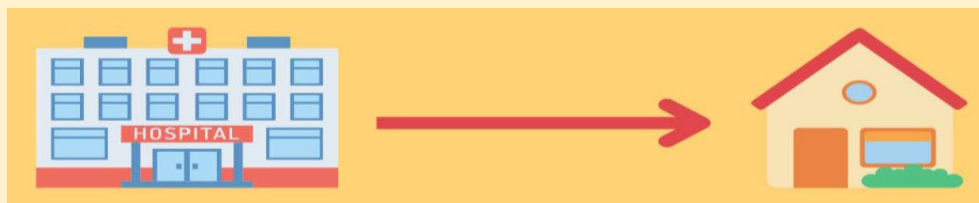
We are hoping to develop and test a **model of hospital discharge that brings together health and social care. But we need your help to work out a few things.**

We are looking to create recommendations of **strategies and approaches to research that are acceptable to ethnic minoritised, linguistically diverse and oppressed populations with multicomplex needs.** Together we will **identify research principles that are sensitive to the needs** of ethnic minoritised, linguistically diverse and oppressed populations with multicomplex needs.

Background

An increasingly multicultural and multilingual UK population with corresponding diversity in health and social care patients and in communities has led to an urgent need for culturally competent practices.

Understanding and addressing the needs of these populations are critical to help patients communicate with and navigate through the health and social care system.



Who are we looking to join us?

We would like to recruit a **group of researchers, community leaders and policy makers** who are likely to have experience of supporting people from ethnic minoritised groups, linguistically diverse and oppressed populations with multicomplex needs.

We would like to hear the experiences of people from any background, culture, or community who have recent experience of supporting people from marginalised groups and communities (in the last 12 months). You will need to be over the age of 18. We will be holding discussions in English, but translators will be available if required.

What will you be asked to do?

In November-December 2024 we will hold a two-round online survey. Each round of the survey will take you less than 20 mins.

In January 2025 we will hold an online workshop with up to 15 people and determine the recommendation of strategies and approaches to research that are acceptable to ethnic minoritised, linguistically diverse and oppressed populations with multicomplex needs.
